Students may form clubs and other groups organized to promote or pursue specialized activities outside the regular classroom. Membership in student organizations, whether school sponsored or non-school sponsored, must be open to all interested and eligible students. The building administrator shall approve school-sponsored student organizations, and a staff member shall attend the meetings or activities to supervise use of the facilities by all student organizations as an advisor or supervisor.

I. Student Clubs

- A. The building administrator shall establish regulations for the operation of school-sponsored clubs and for the use of school facilities by non-school sponsored clubs.
- B. School-sponsored clubs shall be under the direct control of school personnel. Every school-sponsored club shall have written by-laws that outline and direct its operations and procedures.

II. Non-School Sponsored Student Clubs

Non-school sponsored student clubs will have equal access to facilities as non-curriculum related school-sponsored clubs.

Non-school sponsored student clubs shall submit a request for use of school facilities prior to using the facilities. A faculty member or other adult approved in advance shall attend the meetings as a supervisor but may not participate in the group's activities if the group is a student religious group.

III. Student Government

Student councils under the direct control of the building principal or designated faculty representative may be established. Student councils may exercise only the authority expressly delegated to them by the building principal.
