

BOARD OF EDUCATION POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The District derives its legal status from the Constitution of the State of Kansas and from the Kansas statutes as passed and amended by the Legislature of Kansas.

The governance of the district shall be vested in the board. The board is responsible for the general operation, management and control of the school system. In governing the district, the board acts in a policy-making capacity in accordance with the law and may exercise executive, legislative, and/or judicial authority to promote the best interests of the district.

The board may delegate administrative authority to the superintendent or other employees as specified, but retains the power to alter or veto the acts of any or all employees when such acts are deemed contrary to the legal rights or obligations of the district, inconsistent with board policies or goals, or contrary to the best interest of the district.

The board shall have the authority to conduct district business with or without specific statutory delegation. The board may transact all school district business and adopt policies the board deems appropriate to perform its constitutional duty to maintain, develop and operate local public schools.
