Scholarship Selection Process:

- 1. A committee will review all applications. Diana or Kaya Beitz or the allocation committee of the Topeka Public Schools Foundation will serve as the selection committee.
- 2. The recipient will be selected on the strength of the written essay outlining the support received and influence of an adult mentor, coach, sponsor, or teacher who helped them achieve their goals.

Deadlines and Process:

- 1. All applications to be considered must be received by the Topeka Public Schools Foundation by March 15.
- 2. The committee will make a decision on the recipient no later than April 15.
- 3. Upon receipt of documentation of post-secondary enrollment, TPSF will send a check to the student.

Applications must be postmarked no later than March 15 of the current school year.
